What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that the sites visited by users send to their terminals (computers or other mobile or palmtop devices such as smartphones or tablets), where they are stored to be retransmitted to the same sites on subsequent visits. Cookies are used for different purposes, have different characteristics, and can be used both by the owner of the site you are visiting and by third parties. Cookies are essential for the proper functioning of this site. While browsing, the user may also receive cookies relating to sites other than those to which this information refers (these cookies are defined as "third-party"). The managers of these external sites are responsible for identifying the settings, purposes and methods of use of the aforementioned. Below you will find all the information on the cookies installed through this site, and the necessary information on how to manage your preferences regarding them.

3. Processing methods

4. Provision of data

5. Rights of the interested party

According to the provisions of the GDPR, the interested party has the following rights towards the Data Controller:

- obtain confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning him is being processed and, in this case, to obtain access to personal data (Right of access art. 15);
- to obtain the correction of inaccurate personal data concerning him without undue delay (Right of Rectification art. 16);
- obtain the cancellation of personal data concerning him without undue delay and the data controller is obliged to cancel the personal data without undue delay, if certain conditions are met (Right to be forgotten, Article 17);
- obtain the limitation of the processing in certain cases (Right to limitation of the treatment Art. 18);
- receive in a structured format, commonly used and readable by an automatic device, the personal data concerning him provided and has the right to transmit such data to another Data Controller, without impediments by the data controller to whom he provided them, in certain cases (Right to data portability art.20);
- oppose at any time, for reasons connected with his particular situation, to the processing of personal data concerning him (Right to object, Article 21);
- receive without undue delay communication of the violation of personal data suffered by the Data Controller (Article 34);
- withdraw the consent expressed at any time (Conditions for consent art. 7).

Where applicable, the interested party also has the rights referred to in Articles 16-21 GDPR (Right of rectification, right to be forgotten, right to limitation of treatment, right to data portability, right of opposition), as well as the right of complaint to the Guarantor Authority.
